BIDDERS ARE REQUIRED TO AT LEAST ANNUALLY EXECUTE A STATEMENT CERTIFYING THAT THERE ARE NO DELINQUENT TAXES OWED BY THE PERSON REGISTERING AS A BIDDER TO THE COUNTY OR TO ANY TAXING UNIT THAT HAVE TERRITORY IN THE COUNTY.
